How long is the course?

Monday to Friday 8.30 to 6.00

- Day 1 Steam bending and turning
- Day 2 Spindle making and marking-out seat
- Day 3 Carving and finishing the seat
- Day 4 Finishing dried items, and first assembly
- Day 5 Final assembly

Where could I stay during the course?

B&B is available at an excellent pub in the village. Hotel and other B&B's nearby. Simple camping/caravanning available on site.

Where is The Windsor Workshop?

The Workshop is on a farm in the centre of the picturesque old village of West Chiltington - approx 10 miles north of Worthing, and 10 miles SW of Horsham. Trains from London Victoria arrive at Pulborough (3 miles)

How do I sign up?

Contact James Mursell to confirm that your chosen dates are available. A deposit of £150 will secure the booking, with the balance payable prior to the start of the course.

What is the cost?

The price includes all materials, use of tools, and food/refreshments during the day
